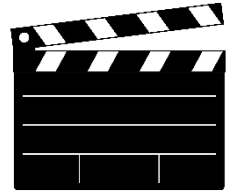

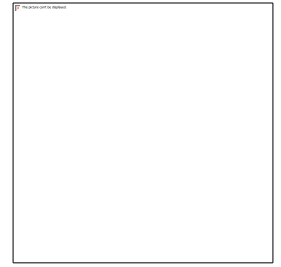
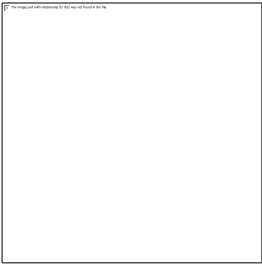


All organ concerts have live video projection on big screen.
